#### Saturday Summer Mass Schedule begins June 7

On June 7-8 we return to our summer schedule of only one Saturday Mass and two on Sunday. The results of the straw poll from last September showed that most people favored the 5:00pm time. Again we will alternate between campuses for the Saturday Mass. 1st, 3rd (and 5th, if needed) Saturdays will be at Becker; 2nd and 4th Saturdays will be at Big Lake. The Sunday morning Mass schedule remains the same: 8:30 at Big Lake and 10:30 at Becker.

#### Mass Schedule in the Fall

I have asked the Parish Council, the parish staff and the Liturgy Committee to discuss the possibility of adopting the Princeton/Zimmerman model for weekend worship. Their merged parish, *Christ Our Light*, has all their Masses at one location on weekends, alternating weekly between their two campuses. Fr. Kevin Anderson told me, "It was one of the very best decisions they ever made with regards to their merger!" He said it helped immensely in getting a sense of being one parish. We anticipate going in that direction this fall. As someone in our parish has reminded me several times: *Until we worship together, we* will not really have a sense of being one parish.

A date of when to begin will be announced in a week or two. Stayed tuned for more information. Fr. Geno Doyle

#### EASTER SALVATION

POPE FRANCIS: MORNING MEDITATION Wednesday, 10 April 2013

At Easter we are restored to our lost dignity and are, consequently, "given hope." This "is salvation. The Lord gives us the dignity we have lost." This "is the road of salvation, and it is beautiful: love alone makes it so. We are worthy, we are men and women of hope."

It happens, however, that at times "we want to save ourselves and we believe that

we can. Maybe we don't exactly say it, but that's how we live." For example when we think: "I can save myself with money. I am secure, I have some money, there is no problem... I have dignity: the dignity of being rich." But all that "is not enough. Think of the Gospel parable, of that man who had the full granary and said: 'I will make another, to have more and more, and then I will sleep peacefully.' And the Lord responds: 'You fool! You will die tonight'. That kind of salvation is wrong, it is temporary, apparent."

Make "an act of faith," saying: "Lord, I believe. I believe in your love. I believe that your love has saved me. I believe that your love has given me a dignity that I did not have. I believe that your love gives me hope." It is "beautiful to believe in love." because "it is the truth. It is the truth of our life."




