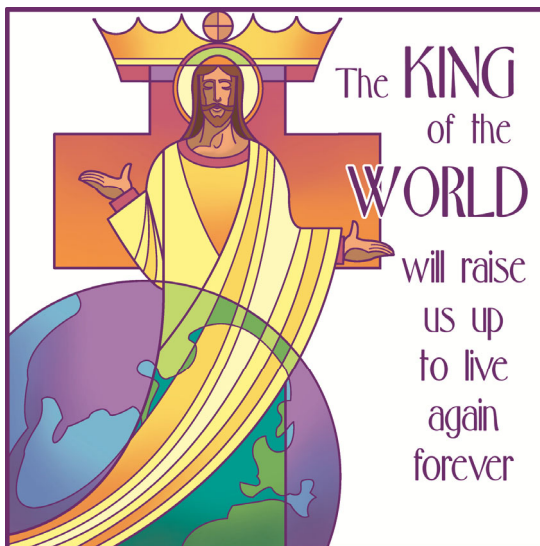

Sunday Readings and Backgrounds

Reading I : 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14

They marveled at his courage.

- The Books of Maccabees tell the story of the second-century B.C. revolt and those who gave their lives for the freedom to worship.
- One of the legendary heroes of this revolt was the mother of seven sons.
- She encouraged her sons to accept martyrdom bravely rather than abandon their faith.

Reading II : 2 Thessalonians 2:16-3:5

May God console your heart.

- In 2 Thessalonians, Paul continues to admonish those who were expecting the world to end immediately.
- He encourages them to stand firm and persevere in faith.
- Paul also asks the people to pray for him and his companions.

Gospel : Luke 20:27-38

God is not a God of the dead but of the living.

- In the gospel, the issue of resurrection is raised by the Sadducees, who did not believe in life after death.
- The Sadducees were aristocratic leaders who criticized the Pharisees and their interpretation of the law.
- Jesus corrects the Sadducees' presumption that life after death must be just like life on earth. In heaven, the marriage relationship will become a new kind of communal life.

Family Reflection:

- Make a prayer list of members of your community, family, or friends who have died in the past year. Place the list in a special prayer space in your home. Every day this week, say a prayer for the people on the list.
- Children in our culture often know very little about death, dying, and eternal life. Take this opportunity to talk with your children about their thoughts, beliefs, maybe even their fears, about death and dying.
- In the Gospel this week, Jesus tells us that after we die, we will not need the same things we did when we were alive, but we will continue to have a relationship with God. You could use the example of a tree to help your children understand what Jesus tells us. When a tree is alive it needs water, soil, and sunlight. When the tree is used to make a table, a toy, or something else it has a new purpose. The tree no longer needs water, soil, or sunlight. Read together the short form of the Gospel, Luke 20:27, 34-38. Tell your children about your hope and faith in the resurrection of the body and eternal life with God. Pray together for those in your family who have died and conclude by praying today's Psalm.
