Much Ado About Many Things

Time for an update on some parish projects:

- ◆ **New Sound System in Becker** - The system installed at Becker will make a significant difference in our worship experience. The Liturgy Committee, Building & Grounds, Finance and Parish Councils supported this effort. Special thanks to the Knights of Columbus Council 9140 for contributing a significant gift to finance the project. Hearing devices are included.
- ◆ **New LED Lighting** - The parking lot lights at the West campus in Becker will be replaced soon with LED lighting. The exterior lighting on the church building at the East campus in Big Lake will also be replaced. Significant improvement in the lighting will be immediate and recovery of energy costs will be just a few months away.
- ◆ **Stained Glass Windows in Big Lake** - Companies that work with stained glass are being consulted as to what might be the best approach to preserve our windows. Many of the frames are deteriorating. This project may need to be done in phases because of costs.
- ◆ **Lighting the Church Sign** - Efforts are underway to install lighting for the sign at Big Lake.
- ◆ **Sidewalk Repairs** - Before the end of July the sidewalk at the south door in Becker will be raised to be flush with the door, and a number of repairs made in the sidewalk at Big Lake.
- ◆ **Carpeting Office Floors** - This will be installed soon in three south-side offices at Becker.
- ◆ **Removal of Oak Tree** - The dead oak tree at Big Lake campus will be removed soon.
- ◆ **Parking Lot Striping** - The lot in Big Lake is to be striped.
- ◆ **Pieta Monument Repair** - The cemetery committee is working to repair the monument at Our Lady of Lake cemetery that was vandalized last December. Repairs include reinforcing the Cross and tuck-pointing the monument.
- ◆ **Items on Hold** - Furnaces in the church in Big Lake and the furnace in the house in Becker need to be replaced. However, these are on hold; more funding is needed.

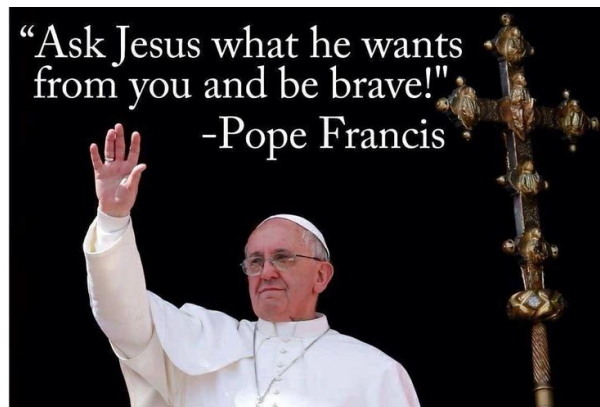

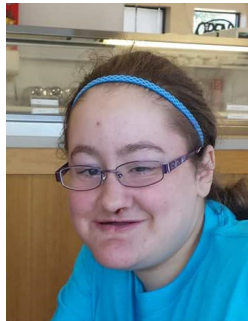
