

GRADE 1 UNIT 3 (Chapters 7-9)

Jesus Christ / December

Home / Online Plan

Beginning the Family Discussion: Start with prayer. Use the Invite process from the first page of Chapter 7 in one of the children's (grades 1-5) books, or the **Pray It!** section from the middle school book.

Introduction to Jesus Christ for parents: In this unit, we learn that Jesus Christ is both true God and true man. The Second Person of the Trinity, he became man to restore us to friendship with God. We call this the Incarnation. Jesus came through Mary to reveal God's love, and to enable us to share in God's life. Through Jesus' example and teaching, we become more aware of how we, as baptized Christians, are to live and witness with our lives. Jesus heals, teaches us to pray, and teaches us to love. Jesus is our healer, teacher, and friend. We need to spend time with friends in order to strengthen and deepen our relationships.

Together, view this video (Parents or older sibling may need to read the text to younger children) as an introduction to the theme of Jesus Christ and discuss the question.
