Mass Intentions—It is the custom of the Catholic Church that priests remember specific intentions at the celebration of the Eucharist. Normally, an offering (customarily \$10 in the Diocese of St. Cloud) is given for a Mass intention. (*Can. 946--The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.*)

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention—in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). CONFIRMATION AND JOURNEY OF FAITH SCHEDULE UPDATE

Due to attendance and distancing limitations in place because of Covid-19, the Bishop has adjusted Confirmation schedules for this fall. In order to stay within the guidelines for number of people allowed in our building, the Bishop has scheduled an additional Confirmation Mass for us. We will retain our original celebration date of Sunday, November 1, at 2pm at our Becker location. We will also have a second Confirmation Mass on Wednesday, November 4, at 7pm at our Becker location. Families with candidates will be asked to consider which date might work best for them, taking into consideration whether sponsors and family members will be able to attend with them. There will be a sign-up process for families, and emails will be going out soon to individual families with more information.

As November 4 was originally scheduled as a Journey of Faith night, the November JOF schedule will be adjusted. Session 1 in Becker and Big Lake will be moved to Wednesday, November 11, and Session 2 in Becker will be moved to November 18.

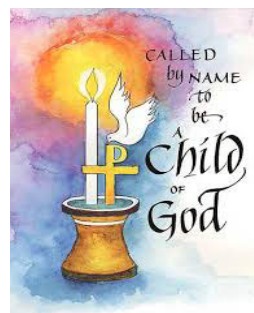
