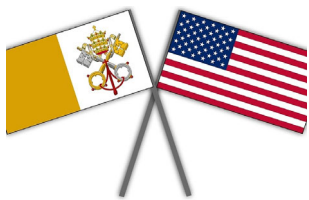
- **Lions Recycle For Sight**--Used eyeglasses/sunglasses/hearing aids can be recycled to provide aid to those in need in our communities.

Mass Intentions--It is the custom of the Catholic Church that priests remember specific intentions at the celebration of the Eucharist. Normally, an offering (customarily \$10 in the Diocese of St. Cloud) is given for a Mass intention. (*Can. 946--The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply the Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share its concern to support its ministers and works.*)

Anyone can request a particular intention for which a Mass can be offered (for a living or deceased person, or for a special intention--in thanksgiving, for peace, healing, etc.). FAITH FORMATION



Flags in Catholic Churches

June 14 is Flag Day! This is also my dad's birthday, and when we were growing up, he would tell us that the flags were up for his birthday! My dad has been gone for 15 years

now, but when Flag Day rolls around every year and I see all the flags flying, I think about my dad and reflect on how symbols and signs can remind us of something beyond what we see.

When I was younger I remember seeing the American flag along with the gold and white flag of Vatican City displayed in the sanctuary. Soon the word came from "somewhere" that it was inappropriate to display flags in the sanctuary and they were moved. Here's what the Bishops have to say about flags... (from the USCCB website)

"Surprisingly to many, there are no regulations of any kind governing the display of flags in Roman Catholic Churches. Neither the Code of Canon law, nor the liturgical books of the Roman rite comment on this practice. As a result, the question of whether and how to display the American flag in a Catholic Church is left up to the judgment of the diocesan bishop, who in turn often delegates this to the discretion of the pastor.

The origin of the display of the American flag in many parishes in the United States appears have its origins in the offering of prayers for those who served during the Second World War (1941-1945). At that time, many bishops and pastors provided a book of remembrance near the American flag, requesting prayers for loved ones – especially those serving their country in the armed forces – as a way of keeping before the attention of the faithful the needs of military families.

The Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy has in the past encouraged pastors not to place the flag within the sanctuary itself, in order to reserve that space for the altar, the ambo, the presidential chair and the tabernacle. Instead, the suggestion has been made that the American flag be placed outside the sanctuary, or in the vestibule of the Church. It remains, however, for the diocesan bishop to determine regulations in this matter."

So, two of the main signs/symbols in the sanctuary are the table, where the bread and wine become Jesus' Body and Blood, and the ambo from which the Word of God is proclaimed. Other items, such as flags, will only distract from the essential action that takes place in the sanctuary. As the bread and wine are presented and consecrated, let us consciously reflect on what lies below the surface of these everyday items, and how our participation in the action of the Eucharist can lead us forth to **"See Christ in others, Be Christ for others!"**
